Proceedings:

Meeting was called to order by Leteta Toney.

- Motion was made and seconded to approve and waive the reading minutes from the March meeting.
- Minutes and waiving the reading of the minutes were approved.

Bookkeeper's Report was given by Kellye Gilbert.

- Today's balance \$10,947.67. Different from what is listed on report.
- Mr. Lucich stated that the Boosters will have to pay for the tower out of pocket and the school will reimburse us.
- Have several last minute, end of school bills to pay.
- Motion was made and seconded to approve the financial report.
- Financial report was approved.

President's Report was given by Leteta Toney.

- Spoke with the manager of Walmart. They have asked us to play for the Grand Reopening and they will give us a donation.
- The students will start at the garden center and march to the ceremony.
- Mr. Lucich will check with Mrs. Sorrells and see if the students can be late to school because of the ceremony.

Band Mom Report was given by Mandi Heath.

- She has purchased potatoes and needs parents to take home bags of potatoes to cook the day of the banquet.
- We will need to have the food ready for the jazz kids to come through early and make their food to go.
- Mr. Lucich will need to see what time a cafeteria worker can be there for the jazz dinner. Otherwise we will need to set up in the concession area and use the warmer.
- Will need tables from the church.
- Planning for around 300.
- Solo and Ensemble is the next weekend and we won't need a concession stand since there are not as many students coming this year.
- Hospitality room volunteers needed for Solo and Ensemble. Heather and Natasha volunteered. Need to have breakfast ready by 8:30am. Will probably be done by 11ish and will need lunch.

Fundraising Coordinator's Report was given by Heather Nerren.

- Hunted down the student who had fundraiser money missing and squared it away.
- We profited \$2,625 from our popcorn fundraiser.
- We profited \$1,740 from our pizza fundraiser.

Uniform Mom Report was given by Dawn Kilpatrick.

- By Friday she will have the QR code for students who would like to buy costumes.
- She will have to coordinate with Mr Lucich over the summer about making covers for the speakers.
- She has a place that can make custom belt buckles with the show logo on them for the costumes.
- We still have Jotform available for any needs.

Pit, Props, & Trailers Report was given by Mark Kilpatrick.

- Will be working on the trailers over the summer.
- Asked about how many fences we will need to make for sure.
- Mr. Lucich will decide on boards based on how many fences we have.
- We will need some dads to assemble the new tower when it comes in.
- Need a trailer puller for graduation.
- Stacey mentioned her neighbor owns Lander's Tires and can check and see if they can get us a deal on some tires for the props.

Band Director's Report was given by Mr. Lucich.

- BOA Nashville will be a two-day competition.
- It was moved from Nissan Stadium to Cookeville at Tennessee Tech.
- Will be October 31st.

Leteta discussed open board positions. Leza Martin will not be returning as Treasurer. Kellye also mentioned that she would love someone to help out and that she has another year. It would be good to bring in another position of someone who just handles sponsorships.
